Life Group Study Questions

Any questions you don't get to might be used by your group members for study and reflection in their personal devotional times. Reflect

- What does it mean that we are the "temple of the Holy Spirit"?
- Pastor Shawn told us that one of the reasons that we're not dead yet is because we are worshippers. How would you define "worship"?
- If our bodies are temples, what other than God do we tend to worship in our temples?
- What are some practical ways that you can worship God throughout your day?
- How might your day to day life look different if you started viewing each moment and each event as an act of worship? What would change?
- 1 Cor 6:20 in the English Standard Version says to "glorify God in your body." What do you think this means? How can we do this?
- What was your biggest take-away from the weekend message?
- Now that we have completed the series, how would you personally answer the question, "Why Aren't You Dead Yet?"
