New & Improved: Easter Small Group Lesson

Scripture

Ephesians 5:8-14 (NIV) For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) and find out what pleases the Lord. Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. For it is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret. But everything exposed by the light becomes visible, for it is light that makes everything visible. This is why it is said: "Wake up, O sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you."

Icebreaker

- Greg opened by sharing his experience with a bad day. Share about a bad day that you have had recently.
- This week we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Why is the way you live different since the Resurrection happened?

Discussion Questions

1. Why is the resurrection of Jesus Christ "good news"?
2. How can Christ's resurrection impact our lives on a daily basis?
3. Paul encourages us to live as children of the light. In what areas is it sometimes challenging to live in the light?
4. What are some ways that life becomes more difficult when you are in the dark?
5. What is one area in your life that you know that you need to choose light instead of darkness?
6. Pastor Greg closed the message this weekend by talking about 3 groups of people - people who have been living in the darkness, people who have experienced the light but have since covered it up, and people who have experienced the light and are still living in it. Which of these three groups best characterizes your spiritual walk right now? What can you do in light of the resurrection to take your next spiritual step?
